

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 60-91

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 114-86 BEING
A BY-LAW WITH RESPECT TO FIRE ROUTES

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of
North Bay deems it desirable to amend the Fire Route By-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH
BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 114-86 be amended by deleting Clause
13 therefrom and inserting in lieu thereof the following
Section 13:

- "13. (1) Any person who contravenes any provision
of this by-law is guilty of an offence and
is subject to a fine recoverable under the
Provincial Offences Act.
- (2) Voluntary payment of a parking infraction
notice according to the amounts set out on
Schedule 20 in strict compliance with the
conditions set out on the parking infraction
notice shall be in lieu of any penalty
otherwise provided by law.
- (3) The owner of a motor vehicle is liable to the
penalty provided for in this section to the
same extent as the driver of such motor
vehicle unless at the time of the offence,
the vehicle was in the possession of some
person other than the owner, without the
owner's consent."


2. This by-law shall come into effect as of the date of
the Order of the Chief Judge of the Ontario Court of
Justice (Provincial Division) to establish the set
fines for the offences set out on Schedule "A".

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 15TH DAY OF APRIL,
1991.

APRIL , 1991.
