

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 95-92

BEING A BY-LAW TO RENAME  
THE STREETS AND ROADS  
WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay may name streets within the City of North Bay pursuant to Section 210 (105) of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to assign or change the names of several streets and roads in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS before passage of the by-law notice of same was published at least once a week for four (4) successive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS before passage of this by-law the Council of the City of North Bay shall hear any person who claims that he will be adversely affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The unnamed road west of Larocque Road between Concessions I and II Lot 23, be named "Mantha Road".
2. The street running northeasterly from Worthington Street East to the Canadian National Railway be named "Industrial Avenue".
3. The unnamed road running northerly from Golf Club Road to the North Bay Golf and Country Club be named "Tupper Drive".
4. The 600 Block of McKenzie Avenue be renamed "Robarts Avenue".
5. The unnamed road running northerly from Highway No. 63 in Lot 1, Concession 2 former Township of Widdifield be named "Lennox Road".
6. That this by-law comes into force and effect upon registration of a copy of this by-law, certified under the hand of the Clerk and the seal of The Corporation of the City of North Bay in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27th DAY OF APRIL, 1992.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1992.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 25TH DAY OF
