NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of North Bay, the following Question;
- (A) "Are you in favour of Daylight Saving Time for the months of May,
 June, July, August, and September, being Proclaimed for the City
 of North Bay each year."
- 2. THAT the Votes of the said electors shall be taken on the said Question at the same time and places and by the Deputy Returning Officer and Poll Clerks, as the annual Municipal Elections.
- 3. A true copy of the Question shall be published in the North Bay Nugget on the days hereinafter mentioned, that is to say, on the Seventh, Fourteenth, and Twenty-first days of November 1946.

- 2) Two O'Clock in the afternoon, the Mayor if requested so to do will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend the Final Summing up of the votes by the Clerk of this Corporation, and one person to attend each Polling Place on behalf of the Persons interested in and desirous of voting in the affirmative on the said Question, and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in an desirous of Voting in the negative on the said Question.
- AT TWELVE O'CLOCK in the Forenoon is hereby appointed as the time and place for summing up by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of votes given in the affirmative and in the negative, respectively.
