AND WHEREAS the calculation for additional seats is different for the Province of Ontario than the Provinces of British Columbia and Alberta. Therefore the Province of Ontario will receive a diminished voice in the House of Commons;

AND WHEREAS Northern Ontario lost 3 Federal Ridings during the last redistribution in 1999, therefore having less of a voice federally;

AND WHEREAS in the next 20 years the population of the Northern Ontario is projected to drop to under 3%, of Ontario population.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of North Bay petition the Prime Minister of Canada, the Right Honorable Stephen Harper, to ask him to use the same formula/ratio for Ontario as is being used for Alberta and British Columbia. Therefore giving Ontario its fair share of representation.

AND Further It Be Resolved that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to leader of the Official Opposition, The Premier of the Province of Ontario, Nipissing MP Antony Rota, Nipissing MPP Minister Monique Smith, FONOM and AMO for their information and support.
