BY-LAW NO. 1977

BEING A BY-LAW to provide that the term of office of all members of the Council of the City of North Bay shall be one year, and that By-law No. 1867 be repealed.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of
North Bay deems it advisable to repeal By-law No. 1867 and
provide that after the passing of this By-law, the term of
office of members of Council of the City of North Bay be one year.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT after the final passing of this By-law the term of office of members of the Council of the Corporation of The City of North Bay shall be one year.
- 2. THAT By-law No. 1867 of the said City of North Bay be and the same is hereby repealed.
- 3. THAT an election shall be held for the members of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for the year 1962 and thereafter as if said By-law No. 1867 had not been passed.
- 4. THIS By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof.
