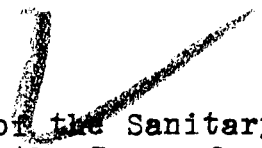


BY-LAW NUMBER 627



BEING a By-law to provide for the extension of the Sanitary Sewerage System on certain Streets within the limits of the Town of North Bay, and all necessary drain connections to the street line on either or both sides, under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act, and to authorize the making of an agreement for temporary advances to meet the cost thereof.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the system of Sanitary Sewerage and connections thereto, existing in the Town of North Bay should be extended along certain streets, within the limits of said Town, and that it is desirable that the said work should be undertaken as a Local Improvement,

AND WHEREAS the Local Board of Health has reported in writing that it is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interests of the Public Health that the Sanitary Sewerage System, at present existing in the said Town, should be extended, for which the plans, specifications and application have been approved of by the Provincial Board of Health, being as follows:

"We hereby certify that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay have submitted to this Board, plans, specifications and an application for the approval of Sewer Extensions of:

at a total estimated cost of Eleven Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-One Dollars, (\$11,191.00), and that this Board has inquired into, and reported upon the work to be undertaken, as to whether the same is calculated to meet the sanitary requirements of the inhabitants affected thereby, and as to whether such works are likely to prove prejudicial to the health of the inhabitants of the Municipality or of any other Municipality liable to be affected thereby, and that the construction of the said works has been approved by the Board."

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay consider it necessary, and by this By-law passed at a general meeting of the Council of the said Town, by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, hereby declares that said Sewerage System, with all necessary connections at present existing in the said Town, should be extended along the streets referred to in Schedule "A", attached to this By-law, between the points mentioned in the said Schedule, as a Local Improvement,

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay by this By-law, passed at a general meeting of the Council of the said Town, by a vote of three-fourths of all members thereof, hereby provides that the sum of One Dollar, (\$1.00) per foot frontage, shall be specially assessed upon the land abutting directly on the work, as well as the total cost of all necessary private drain connections, and that the remainder of the cost of such sewers shall be borne by the Corporation,

BE IT ENACTED, AND IT IS THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay, upon the recommendation of the Local Board of Health, and approval of the Provincial Board of Health, hereby declare that the extension of its Sewerage as a Local Improvement, is necessary and desirable in the public interests on Sanitary grounds.

2. That the said Sewerage System be so extended along the streets and between the points referred to in Schedule "A" attached to this By-law, together with all necessary private drain connections.

3. That the Municipal Council of the said Town of North Bay may agree with the Royal Bank of Canada or any other Bank or person, for temporary advances to meet the cost of the work, pending the completion of the same.

Gentlemen:- Re McPhail St. Sewer.

At a meeting of the Board of Health held today, the following resolution was adopted:

"That, whereas a Public School is now being constructed on McPhail St., and whereas there is no Sanitary Sewer existing on that Street, and whereas the Board of Health, on June 20th., 1921, approved of plans for the construction of such Sewer, from Cassells St. to High St., on McPhail St., the Board hereby recommend that construction of this Sewer be proceeded with at once, as per section 10, Local Improvement Act."

These plans also received the approval of the Provincial Board of Health on June 27, 1921.
