THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2303

Being a By-law to declare it desirable to construct sanitary sewers, private drain connections and a sewage pumping station on certain streets in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay has determined that it is desirable that construction of the works as described in Schedule "A" hereto annexed (and which Schedule "A" shall be deemed to be incorporated in and form part of this by-law) should be undertaken as a Local Improvement.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITYOF NORTH BAY, be a vote of three-fourths of all the members thereof; ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT it is hereby declared desirable to construct as a Local Improvement under the provisions of The Local Improvement Act, being Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1960, Chapter 223, and more particularly Section 8 thereof, the work as described in Schedule "A" hereto annexed.
- 2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall perform all duties which, under the said Act are to be or may be performed by an Engineer.
- 3. THAT notice of Councils intention to undertaken the said work be published as required by the said Act.
