

BY-LAW NO. 1883

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to appoint a City Solicitor.


WHEREAS the appointment of City Solicitor has been vacated by the elevation of H. J. Reynolds, Q.C., to the Bench as Junior Judge of the District Court of the District of Algoma.

AND WHEREAS this Council has examined all applications to fill such vacancy having regard to the qualifications, experience, residence and salary requirements of the applicants respectively.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That A. Thomas Smith be appointed Solicitor for the City of North Bay, effective the 20th day of January A.D. 1959.
2. That A. Thomas Smith shall hold office during the pleasure and subject to the By-laws of the Council and shall perform, with respect to the City of North Bay and the administration of its affairs and of its citizens, all the duties and obligations which by statute or by By-laws are or may be imposed upon the City Solicitor and he shall execute all the authority, powers and rights of such office.
3. That the said A. Thomas Smith shall be paid for his professional services an annual fee of \$4,200.00 together with all out-of-pocket disbursements incurred in the conduct of the City's legal business.
