

BY-LAW NO. 1980

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1889, a by-law to provide for the maintenance, protection, enjoyment and user control of parks, playgrounds, flowered areas and municipal buildings.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend By-law No. 1889 to provide additional control over said parks, playgrounds, flowered areas and municipal buildings by the issuing of permits for fair usage.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Clauses #34, #35, and #36 be renumbered #35, #36, and #37 respectively.
- 2. THAT the hereinafter quote be inserted as Clause #34.

PERMITS

(i) Where applicable for the control and fair usage of an area or facility, the Dept. of Parks & Recreation may, at their discretion, set the time, date and duration of usage.

(ii) That on submission of a schedule by a recognized Sports Executive, the Dept. of Parks & Recreation may issue a blanket permit to cover the scheduled games.

(iii) That permits may be issued for team practices, subject however, that no permits will be issued more than one (1) week in advance of a practice.

(iv) That upon request, not less than two (2) weeks in advance, a permit for an organized picnic may be granted for the purpose of avoiding overcrowding of facilities, but not so as to give the permit holder the exclusive use of any public facilities. The Department reserves the right to refuse any such permit on grounds of inconvenience or danger to the Public by reason of overcrowding or otherwise.

(v) That any misuse or failure to recognize permits held by others will result in the offending parties being refused permits, subject to the review of the Department Committee.


- 3. THAT this By-law shall become effective immediately on the passing thereof.
