BY-LAW NO. 1512

BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 1370 which provides for the Licensing and Regulating of Dogs in the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- That Paragraph 2 of By-Law No. 1370 be repealed.
- That the following be substituted in the said By-Law No. 1370 and to 2. be known as Paragraph 2 of the said By-Law No. 1370:-FROM the First day of $\underline{\text{March}}$ to the First Day of November in the same year, both days inclusive, no owner shall allow his or her dog to run at large in any of the public parks, squares, drives, streets, lanes or other public places in the City of North Bay upon any premises not owned or leased by the owner unless such dog is accompanied by and is under the immediate charge and control of some competent person and such dog is at all times on a leash and any dog found running at large contrary to this provision will be liable to be captured and disposed of as hereinafter provided.
