BY-LAW NO. 1837

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1505 of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend said By-law No. 1505.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT Section 15, Sub-section 2 of By-law No. 1505 be repealed and the following substituted therefor:-

SEC. 15, SUB-SEC. 2:

That the Committee of Adjustment shall consist of three members to be named by City Council and who shall hold office for three years except that on the first appointment the Council shall designate members who shall hold office -

- (a) Until January 1st of the year following the date of appointment
- (b) Until January 1st of the second year following the date of appointment
- (c) Until January 1st of the third year following the date of appointment

respectively so that as nearly as possible one third of the members shall retire each year.

That every appointment to the Committee of Adjustment by the Council shall be subject to the approval of the Minister of Planning and Development.

2. THAT Mr. Carlo Lucenti be appointed to hold office until January 1st of the third year following his date of appointment, being January 1st 1961.

THAT Mr. 0. R. McKerrow be appointed to hold office until January 1st of the second year following his date of appointment, being January 1st 1960.

THAT Mr. E. Follis be appointed to hold office until January 1st of the first year following his date of appointment, being January 1st 1959.

3. THAT this by-law shall not come into force until the persons appointed have been approved by the Minister of Planning and Development of the Province of Ontario.
