BY-LAW NUMBER 578



BEING a By-law to enable Railway Employees to vote at Municipal Elections before Polling Day.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Railway Employees Voting Act" Municipal Councils are authorized to pass a By-law enabling Railway Employees who have reason to believe that they will be absent from the Annual Municipal Elections, to vote at any time between nine o'clock in the morning until five o'clock in the afternoon, during the three days, exclusive of Sunday, immediately preceding the day for holding a poll at the Annual Municipal Election.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows;-

1. That the provisions of the Railway Employees' Voting Act shall apply to the Town of North Bay.
2. That this By-law shall take effect immediately after the passing thereof.
