

BY-LAW NO. 978

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to amend By-Law No. 624 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that By-Law No. 624 of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay should be amended to provide for the regulation and the licensing of busses operating within the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act, R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 233, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT no bus or motor vehicle carrying more than seven passengers for hire shall be operated within the City of North Bay until the owner or operator thereof hath obtained a license issued by the Clerk or other proper Officer of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.
2. THAT the fee for such license shall be \$50.00 for the balance of the year 1930 and \$100.00 for each year thereafter.
3. THAT the license hereinbefore referred to shall expire on the 31st day of December next following the issue thereof.
4. ANY person or persons operating a bus or motor vehicle contrary to provisions of this By-Law shall incur a penalty not exceeding \$25.00.
5. THAT the provisions of this By-Law may be enforced under the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act of the Province Of Ontario.
6. THAT this By-Law shall be effective on the day of the passing thereof.


