THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2432

Being a By-law to authorize the issue of debentures in the principal amount of \$27,760.04 to pay the cost of the construction of concrete sidewalks in the City of North Bay as authorized by By-law No. 2297 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of The Local Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 223, particularly Section 8 thereof, By-law No. 2297 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay authorizing the construction of certain concrete sidewalks as set forth in Schedule "A" to such By-law, was duly approved by Order of the Ontario Municipal Board No. G.187.66 dated the 8th day of August 1966 and was duly passed by two-thirds of all the members of the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay on the 30th day of May 1966;

AND WHEREAS the total cost of the work and the amount to be debentured for such purpose, with the Corporation's share and the owners' share, are shown on Schedule "B" attached hereto;

AND WHEREAS special assessment rolls have been made and certified;

AND WHEREAS for the purpose of paying for the said work it is necessary to borrow upon the credit of the Corporation the sum of \$27,760.04 and to issue debentures therefor bearing interest at the rate of $6\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum payable annually and to provide for the discount, if any, and expenses incidental to negotiating the sale of such debentures;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make the principal of the said debt repayable in annual instalments during the period of ten years next after the issue of such debentures, in such amounts respectively that, with interest in respect of the debt, the aggregate amount payable for principal and insterest each year shall be, as nearly as possible, the same and, subject to any proviso, each instalment of principal may be of an even one hundred dollars, five hundred dollars, one thousand dollars or multiple thereof and, nothwithstanding anything herein contained, the annual instalments of principal and interest may differ in an amount sufficient to admit thereof;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Pursuant to the aforesaid statutory provisions, The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall borrow upon the credit of the said Corporation the sum of \$27,760.04 and debentures shall be issued therefor in denominations of not less than one hundred dollars each. Each debenture shall bear interest at the rate of $6\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum payable annually and shall have coupons attached thereto for the payment of such interest.
- All of the debentures shall bear the same date and shall be issued at one timee in the year 1967 and shall be payable in annual instalments during the period of ten years next after the date of issue thereof and the respective amounts of principal and interest payable in each of such years shall be the amounts designated in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.

- The debentures shall be payable as to both principal and interest in lawful money of Canada at the principal office of the Royal Bank of Canada at North Bay, Ontario; Toronto, Ontario and at Monteal, Quebec.
- The debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation and signed by the head of the Council or by some other person authorized by By-law to sign them and by the Treasurer. The interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer and his signature to them may be written or engraved, lithographed, printed or otherwise mechanically reproduced. The signature of the head of the Council may be written or engraved, lithographed, printed or otherwise mechanically reproduced and, if such debentures are countersigned in writing by the Deputy Treasurer, the signature of the Treasurer thereno may be written or engraved, lithograved, printed or otherwise mechanically reproduced.
- (a) Commencing in the year 1968, and thereafter during the currency of the debentures, the respective sums specified in Column 5 of Schedule "A" attached hereto shall be raised annually for the payment of the debt and the interest thereon and shall be levied and raised annually by a special rate over and above all other rates on all the rateable property in the City of North Bay at the same time and in the same manner as other rates but no greater rate shall be levied in any year for such purpose than is required to pay the instalment after taking into account receipts from special assessments provided in clause (b) hereof, or from any source in respect to the said work.
 - (b) For payment of the abutting owners' portion of the cost and interest thereon, the special assessments set forth in the special assessment roll are hereby imposed upon the lands liable therefor as therein set forth; which special assessment, with a sum sufficient to cover the interest thereon at the rate aforesaid, shall be payable in ten equal instalments, and for that purpose an annual rate per foot frontage is hereby imposed upon each lot entered in the said special assessment roll, according to the assessed frontage thereof, over and above all other rates and taxes, and the said special rate shall be collected annually by the Collector of taxes for the Corporation at the same time and in the same manner as other rates.
- 6. The debentures may contain a clause providing for the registration of the principal thereof pursuant to any statute relating to Municipal debentures in force at the time of issue thereof.


