BY-LAW NO. 2008-19

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY
A PORTION OF THE DELANEY STREET ROAD ALLOWANCE
ABUTTING LOTS 139, 140, 145 & 146 PLAN M-62,
BETWEEN MARGARET STREET AND HELEN STREET,
IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the Delaney Street road allowance abutting Lots 139, 140, 145 and 146, Plan M-62, between Margaret Street and Helen Street, be closed, stopped up and sold to the abutting owners;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2007-523 passed on the 23rd day of July, 2007, Council approved the closure of part of the Delaney Street road allowance;

AND WHEREAS the Delaney Street road allowance abutting Lots 139, 140, 145 and 146, Plan M-62 is hereby declared to be surplus;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That certain part of the Delaney Street road allowance abutting Lots 139, 140, 145 and 146, Plan M-62 designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 36R-12377 is hereby closed, stopped up and conveyed.
2. The City shall transfer Parts 1 and 2, Plan 36R-12377 to the owners of the lands abutting thereon, their successors or assigns, upon receipt of the consent in writing of the abutting registered owner, if the transfer is to be to a person other than the abutting registered owner.
- 3.(a) Subject to paragraph (b), in the event that an abutting owner to the said road allowance does not consent to the disposition of the road allowance within 60 days of the date of the passing of this by-law, then the clerk shall, upon request of an abutting owner of the opposite side of the road allowance, give 30 days notice by prepaid registered mail to the abutting owner of the road allowance to the effect that if the abutting owner does not agree to purchase one-half of the abutting road allowance at a pro-rata share of the survey, legal, advertising costs and purchase price incurred in the road allowance closing, then the said one-half of the road allowance may be transferred to the opposite owner for the same cost.


(b) Upon receipt of an Irrevocable Consent of the disposition of the road allowance from the adjacent owner then that portion of the road allowance may be transferred upon registration of the by-law.
4. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY, 2008.
