BY-LAW NO. 1518

BEING A BY-LAW to change the name of a Street in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS a request has been made to the City Council of the City of North Bay to change the name of a street in the said City to honour the Algonquin Regiment.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. That as the Headquarters of the famous Algonquin Regiment were in North Bay during the last Great War and the said Regiment brought honour to the said City, IT IS DESIROUS TO PERPETUATE THE NAME OF THE SAID REGIMENT.
- 2. That the Street formerly known as Alock Avenue be changed to read "Algonquin Avenue".
- 3. That this By-Law shall be of full force and effect when it has received the necessary advertising and certification of the Judge of the District Court of the District of Nipissing.

READ a Second time in Open Council this 8th day of June, 1948.
