BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the closing hours of all those classes of shops hereinafter set out and all other shops in which two or more classes of trades are carried on, where the principal trade of such shop or shops is hereinafter set out.

WHEREAS certain petitions have been received by this Council from the occupiers of shops belonging to the classes of shops hereinafter set out, and situate within the limits of the City of North Bay, from which it appears that such occupiers have agreed and have requested that this Council pass a by-law regulating the closing hours of such shops;

AND WHEREAS this Council deems it expedient to pass a by-law accordingly, under the provisions of The Municipal Act as enacted by Statutes of Ontario 1961-62 chapter 86 section 43;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That this by-law shall regulate the closing hours of all shops within the City of North Bay, belonging to the following classes:

Hardware & Sporting Goods Stores Department & Variety Stores Boot & Shoe Stores Camera & Hobby Shops Drapery & Fabric Shops Office Equipment and Office Men's Wear Stores Florists Shops Ladies' Wear Stores Supply Stores Jewellers, China & Gift Stores Boys' and Children's Wear Stores Builders Supply and Lumber Dealers Furriers Tire & Automotive Supply Stores Furniture & Household Appliances Stores Mail Order Stores Paint & Painters' Supplies StoresDiscount Stores War Surplus Stores

- 2. That except as hereinafter provided, all shops within the City of North Bay belonging to the said classes, shall be closed and remain closed during the hours between seven o'clock in the afternoon of every day except Friday, and five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day, and between nine o'clock in the afternoon of each and every Friday and five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day, provided that -
 - (a) On the six days of business immediately preceding Christmas Day, all shops belonging to the said classes shall be closed and remain closed during the hours between nine o'clock in the afternoon of each of the said six days and five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day.
 - (b) Whenever a holiday, other than Sunday, as defined in sub-section 10 of Section 30 of The Interpretation Act, R.S.O. 1960, chapter 191, occurs on a day of the week other than Monday, all of the said shops shall be closed during the hours between nine o'clock in the afternoon of the day next preceding such holiday and five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day.
- 3. Every occupier of any such shop and every agent and servant of such occupier who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law shall, upon conviction, forfeit and pay an penalty of One Hundred Dollars for the first offence, and Three Hundred Dollars for each subsequent offence, together with all costs which may be imposed by the convicting Magistrate.

This by-law shall take effect on the 10th day of November A.D. 1962.

By-laws numbers 390, 584, 1294, 1895, 1970 and 1979 and all other by-laws and parts of by-laws of the City of North Bay inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law are hereby repealed.
