BY-LAW NO. 2055

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for the election and nomination of members of Council and any local Board or Commission any members of which are required to be elected by ballots by the municipal electors of the City of North Bay.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, by authority of The Municipal Act, being Chapter 249, R.S.O. 1960, as amended, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- (1) That the election of members for Council and any local Board or Commission required to be elected by ballots shall be held on the second Monday in December of each year, and that the Polls shall be open from 11:00 A.M. to 7:30 P.M.
- (2) That the meeting of the electors for the Nomination of Candidated for members of Council and any local Board or Commission required to be elected by ballots shall be held on the Friday immediately preceding the first Monday in the month of December at 7:30 P.M. in the afternoon in the Council Chamber of the City Hall.
- (3) That By-law No. 1467 and all other by-laws inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.
