

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2329

Being a By-law authorizing Canadian National Railways - Northern Ontario Area to carry out engineering studies re proposed widening of C.N.R. railway bridge at Algonquin Avenue, North Bay, Ontario.

WHEREAS Canadian National Railways - Northern Ontario Area by letter dated June 17th, 1966, has requested The Corporation of the City of North Bay to enact the necessary By-law authorizing it to carry out the necessary engineering studies for the purpose of providing The Corporation of the City of North Bay with estimates of the cost of widening the C.N.R. overhead railway bridge at Algonquin Avenue at the expense of the City;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to enact the within By-law;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Canadian National Railways - Northern Ontario Area be and it is hereby authorized to carry out the necessary engineering studies to provide The Corporation of the City of North Bay with estimates of the cost of widening the C.N.R. overhead railway bridge at Algonquin Avenue, North Bay.
2. That the cost of carrying out the aforesaid engineering studies be borne by The Corporation of the City of North Bay and paid to Canadian National Railways - Northern Ontario Area.
3. That an application be made to The Board of Transport Commissioners for Canada for a contribution or grant from the Railway Grade Crossing Fund to assist in defraying the cost of widening the Algonquin Avenue subway or underpass, including the cost of the aforesaid engineering studies.
4. That the City Engineer furnish Canadian National Railways - Northern Ontario Area with the necessary information required in Items 1 to 7, both inclusive, as set forth in the aforesaid letter dated June 17th, 1966, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" to this By-law.
