BEING A By-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF POLICE OFFICER LOUIS CUSSON AS SPECIAL COLLECTOR OF LICENSE FEES FOR THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:-

(1). THAT Police Officer Louis Cusson be appointed as special collector of license fees under the supervision of the Chief of Police of the Town of North Bay at a salary of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per month beginning on the Fifteenth of December, 1924.

(2). The duties of the said Louis Cusson shall be to collect all poll taxes and dog taxes and do such other special work of a like or similar nature that may be assigned to him by the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay at any time.

(3). In addition to the salary of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per month above referred to the said Louis Cusson shall receive a commission of ten per cent (10%) on all such taxes collected by him with a minimum commission of Fifty Cents (.50) to be allowed the said Louis Cusson on each individual collection.
