## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 93-77

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 68-77 BEING A BY-LAW TO IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF CERTAIN LANDS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Housing has withdrawn the condition requiring the passage of a geodetic by-law prior to final registration of the Plan of Subdivision;

AND WHEREAS the Council by Clause No. 2 of the General Government Committee Report #37-77 adopted at its regular meeting held Monday, 27 June, 1977 authorized that By-law No. 68-77 be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 68-77 being a by-law to impose restrictions on certain lands in the City of North Bay be and is hereby repealed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 25TH DAY OF JULY, 1977.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED
