BY-LAW NUMBER 588.

BEING a By-law to provide for the appointment of a Town Foreman for the Town of North Bay, and to define the duties and to provide for the salary that shall be paid to the said official.

The Town Foreman shall have supervision of all public works, shall look after the yards, stables and stores, and have full charge of all employees of the said Corporation with the exception of Fire and Police Departments, Town Hall Staff, and those engaged in the collection of night-soil and garbage.

He shall make a daily report of employees time and work done, which shall be filed by the Town Clerk for checking time sheets. He shall also prepare statements showing all stocks and equipment belonging to the Fire, Water & Light, and Public Works Committees on hand at the end of every year.

That Mr. Alex. C. Doyle shall be appointed Town Foreman, and his salary shall be set at the sum of \$125.00 per month, payable on the 15th and 30th of each month.

This By-law shall come into effect immediately after passing.
