ballots;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of North Bay desires to use composite ballots which have been drafted pursuant to subsections 1 to 8 of Section 41 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1972.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The form of composite ballot as shown in Schedule "A" to this By-law, shall be used in the Election respecting the Offices of Trustees for the Nipissing District Roman Catholic Separate School Board, and for the Office for the Separate School Members of the Nipissing Board of Education.
- 2. This By-law is subject to the approval of the Treasurer of Ontario and Minister of Economics and Intergovernmental Affairs.
