BY-LAW NO. 29 - 92

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE AND STOP UP  
PART OF CARTIER STREET TO VEHICULAR  
TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to close and stop up Cartier Street at Algonquin Avenue to vehicular traffic in the City of North Bay pursuant to Section 298 (1c) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302.

AND WHEREAS notice of this proposed By-Law was published for four successive weeks and the Council has heard in person, any person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, who claims to be prejudicially affected and who applies to be heard pursuant to Section 301 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That part of Cartier Street as shown on Plan of Reference WP25-84-01 on file with the City Clerk is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed and upon a certified copy of this By-Law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 20TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1992.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 2ND DAY OF MARCH 1992.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 2ND DAY OF MARCH , 1992.
