

BY-LAW NUMBER 1169

MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS

BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the traffic in the public streets in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend By-Law Number 1067 for regulating traffic in the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Clause 6 of By-Law Number 1067 be and the same is hereby repealed.
2. Clause 6 of By-Law Number 1067 is hereby amended by striking out all words of said Clause 6 so that the said Clause shall now read as follows:-- The driver or operator of a vehicle intending to turn to the left into an intersecting highway shall approach such intersection as closely as practicable to the centre line of the highway and the left turn shall be made by passing to the right of such centre line where it enters the intersection, and upon leaving the intersection by passing to the right of the centre line of the highway then entered.

Read a First time in Open Council this 17th day of September, 1934.
Read a Second time in Open Council this 17th day of September, 1934.
Read a Third time in Open Council and passed this 1st day of October, 1934.
