BY-LAW NO. 1970

BEING A BY-LAW to regulate the closing hours of all places of business, within the limits of the City of North Bay, which fall within the following classifications:

Boots and Shoes Children's and Boys' Wear Department Stores Variety Stores Dry Goods Stores Hardware Stores

Furniture and Drapery Furriers Music and Records Jewellers Paints and Oils Shoe Repairers
Men's Wear
Ladies' Wear
Bake Shops
Camera and
Crafts

WHEREAS an Application duly signed in accordance with the provisions of Section 78, Subsection (4) of The Factory, Shop and Office Building Act R.S.O. 1960, Chap. 130 has been presented to the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay, praying that a by-law be passed amending and repealing all provisions, by-laws or provisions in previous by-laws inconsistent with the terms of the said Application, as they affect those classes of shops hereinabove set out.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT, except as hereinafter provided, all shops within the limits of the City of North Bay belonging to those classes of shops hereinabove set out, shall be closed during the hours between 7.00 o'clock in the afternoon of each day and 5.00 o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day.
- 2. THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph one, the said shops shall be closed during the hours between 9.00 o'clock in the afternoon of Friday of each week and 5.00 o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day.
- 3. THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of the two next preceding paragraphs whenever a statutory or proclaimed holiday occurs on a day of the week other than Monday, the said shops shall be closed at the hour of 9.00 o'clock on the day next preceding such holiday and remain closed until 5.00 o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following such holiday.
- 4. THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of the three next preceding paragraphs; on the six days of business immediately preceding Christmas Day, the said shops shall be closed between the hours of 9.00 o'clock in the afternoon of each of the said six days and 5.00 o'clock in the forenoon of each next following day.
- 5. THAT all provisions of By-law No. 584 and of every other by-law and amendment thereto, inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law are hereby repealed.
- 6. THAT every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of \$100.00 for the first offence, and \$300.00 for each subsequent offence.
- 7. THIS by-law shall take effect on the passing thereof.
