THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 211-89

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 57-89 TO PROVIDE FOR VOLUNTARY PAYMENT OF PENALTIES.

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend Traffic By-law No. 57-89 to provide for voluntary payment of penalties.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- By-law 57-89 is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 4 of section 35 (5) (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:
 - "35 (5) (a) (4) That in the event of the failure to make voluntary payment of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for an offence under subsection (4) hereof within ten (10) days, then procedures under the Provincial Offences Act shall apply."
- 2. Section 2 of By-law 172-89 is hereby repealed.
- 3. By-law 57-89 is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 5 in section 35 (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 - "35 (5) (a) (5) That in the event of the failure to make voluntary payment of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for an offence under subsection (2) hereof within ten (10) days, then procedures under the Provincial Offences Act shall apply."
- 4. By-law 57-89 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph (6) to section 35 (5) (a):

"35 (5) (a) (6) That in the event of the failure to make voluntary payment of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for an offence under section 32 (3) or section 32 (5) hereof within ten (10) days, then procedures under the Provincial Offences Act shall apply."

5. This by-law comes into effect upon being passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1989.
