BY-LAW NO. 39-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO ASSUME PART OF KING STREET

WHEREAS Section 298 (1) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302 authorizes the Council to pass by-laws to establish highways;

AND WHEREAS part of King Street has been improved, at the expense of the abutting owner, Bell Canada, to municipal engineering standards required for municipal maintenance of publicly travelled highways;

AND WHEREAS the abutting owners have consented to this By-law,


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Part of King Street, shown on Registered Plan M-177 in the City of North Bay, from Lansdowne Avenue to a point 100 feet southerly thereof is hereby opened, adopted and assumed for public use as a travelled highway to be maintained by The Corporation of the City of North Bay.
2. This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 1ST DAY OF MARCH, 1982.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15TH DAY OF MARCH 1982.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 15TH DAY OF MARCH 1982.
