THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 143-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 106-81

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to prohibit off-road vehicles from municipal parks and to prohibit vehicles from other lands owned by the City.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 1 (f) of By-law No. 106-81 is hereby amended by adding "or an off-road vehicle" to the end thereof.
- 2. Section 13 of By-law 106-81 is hereby deleted and the following section is inserted in lieu thereof:
 - "13. (a) Subject to subsection (c), no person shall operate any vehicle in any park, except on a designated roadway.
 - (b) Subject to subection (c), where authorized signs are on display, no person shall operate any vehicle on any land owned by the City which is not a highway.
 - (c) This section does not apply to a bicycle, tricycle, child's sleigh or carriage, or service or construction vehicles operated by or under contract with the City.
 - (d) The Director of Parks and Recreation may erect "Vehicles Prohibited" signs
 - (i) on City parks, or,
 - (ii) on City owned lands other than highways with the approval of the Chief Administrative Officer.
 - Any person who contravenes a provision of this section is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is subject upon a first offence to a penalty of \$50.00 and upon a subsequent offence to a penalty of not less than \$200.00 and not more than \$500.00, exclusive of costs."

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 21st DAY OF JULY, 1986 READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 5th DAY OF AUGUST, 1986 READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 5th DAY OF AUGUST, 1986.
