BY-LAW NO. 170-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 2-82. (EDNA ST., WHIPPLETREE DR., COURIERS, FOREN ST.-DISABLED PERSONS)

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to provide for additional through highways comprised of part of Edna Street and part of Whippletree Drive.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to include courier vehicles as permitted vehicles within loading zones.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways.

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 198, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating traffic on highways.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Subsection (d) of section 1 is hereby amended by adding the following thereto:
 - "....and motor vehicles with permanent exterior courier service markings, the owner of which holds a current public commercial vehicle licence from the Ontario Highway Transport Board".
- 2. (a) Schedule 8 of Traffic By-law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by adding the following to section E:
 - " ROAD FROM TO
 - Edna Street Metcalfe Street Franklin Street"
 - (b) Schedule 8 of Traffic By-law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by adding the following to section W:
 - ROAD FROM TO
 - 8. Whippletree Drive Surrey Street Francis Avenue"
- 3. That Traffic By-law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by adding thereto a Schedule 19 as follows:
