## BY-LAW NUMBER 570

BEING a By-law to authorize the construction of a bitulithic pavement, concrete curb, gutter and widening of sidewalk on Main Street from Sherbroke to Foran streets in the Town of North Bay, and to authorize the making of an agreement for the temporary advance to meet the cost thereof.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the Council of the Town of North Bay in accordance with "An Act Respecting Local Improve ments" for the construction under the provisions of the said Act of ; Bitulithic Pavement, concrete curb, gutter, and widening of sidewalk on Main street from Sherbrocke to Foran streets, which petition was signed by at least two thirds in number of the owners representing at least one-half of the value of the lots liable to be specially assessed according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality, and the number of such owners and the value of such lots liable to be specially assessed as appears by the last revised Assessment Roll aforesaid, having been ascertained and finally determined in accordance with and as provided for by the said Act.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay consider it necessary and by this By-law passed at a general meeting of the Council of the said Town by a vote of two-thirds of all the Members thereof, hereby declare that all necessary drain connections from the existing sewer to the street line on either or both sides should be constructed on Main street from Sherbrooke to Foren atreets as a Local Improvement.

AND WHEREAS the said Council has decided to execute the said work under the direction and supervision of its own officers, and it is desirable to authorize the said work and to authorize the Council to provide from the funds of the Municipality or to raise by way of loan upon the debentures of the Municipality fifty per cent of the cost of the construction of said pavement, concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk widening, in addition to the part of the cost to be provided by the Municipality, and to authorize the making of an agreement for temporary advances for meeting the cost of the said work and the payment of such cost by the Town Treasurer on the certificate of the Town Engineer approved by the Council. The Corporation of the Town of North Bay by the Council thereof by an affirmative vote of three-fourths of the Members of the Council therefore enact as follows;-

- 1. That the said Bitulithic Pavement, concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalk widening, and necessary drain connections on Main streetfrom Sherbrooke to Foran streets, and all work connected therewith, shall be constructed, laid down and completed under the direction and supervision, and to the full satisfaction of the Town Engineer or such other person or persons he shall appoint to oversee the same.
- 2. That immediately upon the completion of the said work, the Town Engineer or other person in charge thereof, shall report in writing under his hand to the Town Clerk the total cost of the said work together with the number of lineal feet therein.
- 3. That the said work shall be constructed as "Local Improvements" and the cost thereof shall be paid in the manner provided by such Act.
- 4. It shall and may be lawful for the Mayor and Treasurer to borrow from any person or persons, body or bodies corporate, who may be willing to advance the same, such sums or sum of money as may be required to pay for such Local Improvements, and any money so borrowed shall be repaid out of the proceeds of the debentures to be issued for on account of the said work when completed.

5. The Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay consists of ten members and 9 members of the said Council voted in favour of this By-law, and one Member against same.
