BY-LAW NO. 1828

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to authorize the construction of a Railway Siding across Timmins Street in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Brewers Warehousing Co. Limited desire to have a railway siding constructed, maintained and operated by the Canadian Pacific Railway Company across Timmins Street in the City of North Bay, Ontario.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Corporation of the City of North Bay consents to the construction, maintenance and operation by the Canadian Pacific Railway Company of the aforesaid siding on and across Timmins Street in the City of North Bay, subject to conditions set forth in Schedule "A" attached hereto and which forms part of this by-law and according to Plan F-7-23 dated at Sudbury, Ontario, May 15th, 1957 as indicated in Schedule "B" attached hereto and which forms part of this by-law.
- 2. THAT this by-law shall come into use on the said day of the final passing thereof.

SCHEDULE "A" BY-LAW NO. 1828

THAT in consideration of the Council of the City of North Bay granting permission to construct a siding over and upon Timmins Street to serve the Brewers Warehousing Co. Limited building that so long as no railway cars will be spotted on the siding so that such cars will not protrude beyond a point 20 feet westerly of the west wall of the building so located at the date of passing of this By-law.

THAT the storm drain, watermain and sanitary sewer force main presently located on Timmins Street and over and upon which the siding is to be constructed shall be protected in accordance with the Board of Transport Commissioners standards which require such municipal services be encased in pipes of a larger diameter to permit withdrawal and repairs when necessary without disrupting the railway.
