## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 121-78

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO CLOSE AND STOP UP THAT PART OF OAKWOOD AVENUE DESIGNATED AS PART 1, PLAN 36R-5023 AND PART OF A LANE DESIGNATED AS PART 5, PLAN 36R-5023 IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it necessary to close and stop up that part of Oakwood Avenue designated as Part 1, Plan 36R-5023 and Part of a lane designated as Part 5, Plan 36R-5023 in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS Notice of this proposed By-law was published for four successive weeks and the Council or a Committee of Council has heard in person any person or his representative who claims to be prejudicially affected in accordance with Section 446 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That part of Oakwood Avenue designated as Part 1, Plan 36R-5023 and part of a lane designated as Part 5, Plan 36R-5023 for the Registry Division of Nipissing is hereby closed and stopped up.
- This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed and registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1978.
