BY-LAW NO. 1747

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 1955 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS OR STREETS IN THE CITY ~~SEPARATED TOWN~~ OF NORTH BAY IN THE ~~COUNTY~~ DISTRICT OF NIPISSING

WHEREAS under The Highway Improvement Act a by-law to provide for expenditure on roads or streets may be submitted annually to the Minister of Highways for approval.

AND WHEREAS the expenditure for the said purpose last year was \$....~~94,100~~.... which required a levy of ....~~4.14~~... mills on the assessment of \$.22,680.953.....

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the said City/~~Separated Town~~ desires to expend for the said purpose this year \$.129,400..... for which it is prepared to levy an estimate of .5,31.... mills on the assessment of \$.24,387.549.....

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said City/~~Separated Town~~ enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 129,400 is hereby appropriated from moneys raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure on construction and maintenance of the roads or streets under its jurisdiction during the year 1955 as follows:

(2) The said moneys shall be expended on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

(3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways.
