

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 81-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN AGREEMENT WITH
THE NATIONAL MUSEUMS OF CANADA REGARDING
A STEAM TRAIN.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to enter into an Agreement with The National Museums of Canada to provide for the operation of a steam locomotive and a train of 5 passenger cars for the North Bay celebration known as the One Hundred Years of Rail.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to enter into that certain Memorandum of Understanding with The National Museums of Canada being Contract No. 1630-2-T-16 dated May 10, 1982.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the said Memorandum of Understanding dated May 10, 1982.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 10TH DAY OF MAY, 1982.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25th DAY OF May 1982.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 25th DAY OF May , 1982.
