

BY-LAW NO. 1391

BEING A BY-LAW to cover the renumbering of properties in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is estimated that it will cost in the neighbourhood of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2000.00) to renumber the houses in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to obtain the opinion of the Electors of the Municipality of the City of North Bay as to the advisability of proceeding with the renumbering of properties in the said Municipality.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That at the next annual election the following question shall be submitted to the electors:

Are you in favour of renumbering properties in the City of North Bay (by the 100 to the block system) at a cost not to exceed \$2000.00.?.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15th day of NOVEMBER 1943.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15th day of NOVEMBER 1943.

RULES OF ORDER WERE SUSPENDED AND BY-LAW READ A THIRD TIME SHORT AND PASSED THIS 15th day of NOVEMBER 1943.
