BY-LAW NO. 2012-60

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION OF THE UNOPENED BOURKE STREET ROAD ALLOWANCE IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that portion of the unopened Bourke Street Road Allowance, in a block McLaren Street, Jane Street and Harvey Street abutting Lot 49, Plan 77 and Lot 511, Plan 64 be closed and stopped up;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2012-138 passed on the 21st day of February, 2012, Council approved the closure of the unopened Bourke Street Road Allowance;

AND WHEREAS the unopened Bourke Street Road Allowance abutting Lot 49, Plan 77 and Lot 511, Plan 64 is hereby declared to be surplus;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That certain part of the unopened Bourke Street Road Allowance, in a block McLaren Street, Jane Street and Harvey Street abutting Lot 49, Plan 77 and Lot 511, Plan 64 and designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Reference Plan 36R-13219 is hereby closed and stopped up.
- 2. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 5TH DAY OF MARCH, 2012.
