## THE COPPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 106-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF PUBLIC PARKS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS Section 208 (57) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, provides that by-laws may be passed for maintaining, operating, and managing parks, recreational areas and playgrounds within the municipality.

AND WHEREAS Section 208 (42) of The Municipal Act provides that by-laws may be passed prohibiting the use of vehicles in parks in the City of North Bay.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this By-law: -
  - (a) "City" means The Corporation of the City of North Bay.
  - (b) "Council" means the municipal council of the City.
  - (c) "Director" means the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation or such other city employees designated by resolution of Council to act in his place.
  - (d) "Fire" means the combustion of substances with oxygen and air so as to give out bright light and heat, but does not include the use only of coals for the purpose of cooking food above such coals where the coals are enclosed by a non-combustible structure designed for such purpose.
  - (e) "Park" means any parcel or tract of land owned by the City and set aside and hereby dedicated by Schedule "A" of this by-law for the purposes of a public park, and any land under the ownership or control of the City and used by the public for park or recreation purposes.
  - (f) "Vehicle" includes an automobile, motorcycle, motor assisted bicycle and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power, including a motorized snow vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, self-propelled implement of husbandry or road building machine.

## THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION

2. The Parks and Recreation Department of the City of North Bay shall be under the control and supervision of the Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of North Bay, who is responsible to the City Administrator and to Council for administration of the Department.

## PARKS REGULATIONS

Litter

3. No person shall throw or deposit or cause to be deposited any rubbish, refuse, garbage, waste or litter in a park, except in receptacles provided for the purpose.

- 4. No person shall deposit, place, store or maintain upon any public area of the City any stone, brick, sand, concrete or other materials which may impede the free passage of water, air and fertilizer to the roots of any trees, shrubs or turf growing therein, except by written permit of the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Animals 5. (a) No person shall bring any animal into a park unless the animal is held by a leash not exceeding six feet in length.
  - (b) No person who has brought an animal on a proper leash into a park shall permit such animal to run unleashed therein.
  - (c) No person shall bring any animal into an area that is designated as a public swimming area.
- Fire 6. No person shall light, make, or use any fire in any public park without the prior written permission of the Director of Parks and Recreation.
- Stones, 7. No person shall throw stones or other missiles or swing any golf clubs or other dangerous instruments within any public park in a manner that is dangerous to the safety of other persons.
- Posting 8. No person shall post, stencil or otherwise affix any notice or bills or other papers upon any structure, tree or thing in or on any public park or any boulevard without the prior written permission of the Director of Parks and Recreation.
- Sale of 9. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) no person shall expose for sale in any public park or on any boulevard any merchandise or goods without having obtained a permit in writing from the Director of Parks and Recreation.
  - (b) Subsection(a) does not apply to the sale of liquid or frozen refreshments where the vendor holds all necessary permits and licences in connection with the sale of such refreshments; nor does Subsection (a) apply to city-owned buildings which are not under the direction of the Director of Parks and Recreation.
- Sports 10. No person shall play match or organized games of base-ball, cricket, football, lacrosse, hockey, softball, soccer or other games or sports within public parks without having obtained a permit, in writing, from the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Parking 11. No person shall park a vehicle in a park overnight, unless a sign is on display to indicate that the area is so designated by the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Traffic 12. (a) No person shall drive any vehicle on any roadway Speed in a park at a greater rate of speed than 25 kilometres per hour, or in a manner that interferes with or endangers any person in a park.
  - (b) Upon every roadway or part of a roadway in a park where a sign is on display to indicate the direction of traffic, vehicular traffic shall move only in the direction so indicated.

- Roadway 13. No person shall drive, propel, draw or ride a vehicle other than a bicycle, tricycle or child's sleigh or carriage on any part of any park except on a designated and improved roadway or parking lot.
- Trucks 14. No truck may be operated or driven in any public park or ground other than on a designated roadway or parking lot without the prior written permission of the Director of Parks and Recreation.
- Construc- 15. During any building operations in the course of which tion a public tree or shrub is likely to be injured, the builders shall obtain a written permit from the Parks and Recreation Department and shall erect protective barriers as designated and approved by the Parks and Recreation Department around such public trees and shrubs.
- No 16. The parks designated on Schedule "A" hereto are Liquor hereby designated as recreational areas where the possession of liquor is prohibited pursuant to Section 46a of The Liquor Licence Act, 1975, as amended.
  - 17. No person shall be within the limits of those parks with beaches designated on Schedule "B" hereto between the hours of 11 o'clock p.m. and 6 o'clock a.m.
- Repeal 18. By-law No. 1889 of the City of North Bay and By-law No. 720 of the former Township of West Ferris and any amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
- Penalty 19. Any person who contravenes any provision of the by-law is guilty of an offence and is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 exclusive of costs, which fine is recoverable under The Provincial Offences Act.
