

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 102-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF FIRST AVENUE WEST BETWEEN FRASER STREET AND FERGUSON STREET AND MCINTYRE STREET BETWEEN WYLD STREET AND SHERBROOKE STREET.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Canadian Forces Base, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of First Avenue West between Fraser Street and Ferguson Street and McIntyre Street between Wyld Street and Sherbrooke Street, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the portion of First Avenue West between Fraser Street and Ferguson Street and McIntyre Street between Wyld Street and Sherbrooke Street in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 12:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Sunday, September 12, 1993, for the purpose of Freedom of the City Ceremony.
2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
3. That prior to 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 12th day of September, 1993, the Director of transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portion of First Avenue West and McIntyre Street to their condition prior to the above closure.
