THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 115-80

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE HOLDING OF AN ADDITIONAL ADVANCE POLL FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING VOTES OF ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY WHO EXPECT TO BE UNABLE TO VOTE ON POLLING DAY.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 (2) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1977, the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to hold an Advance Poll in addition to the Advance Poll to be held on Saturday, November 1, 1980.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 That in addition to the Advance Poll to be held on Saturday, November 1, 1980, there shall be held an Advance Poll on Wednesday November 5, 1980, for the purpose of receiving votes of the electors of the City of North Bay who expect to be unable to vote on Polling Day, Monday, November 10, 1980.
The Advance Poll shall be open from nine o'clock in the forenoon until eight o'clock in the afternoon and polling shall be held so far as possible in the same manner as polling on the regular Polling Day, November 10, 1980.

This by-law shall become effective when passed by Council.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1980. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8th DAY OFSeptember 1980. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 8th DAY OF September 1980.
