

BY-LAW NO. 2044

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for closing part of a certain lane in the City of North Bay as shown on Registered Plan No. 57 in the Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to close part of a certain lane shown on registered Plan 57 and lying within the limits of the said Corporation of the City of North Bay and to sell and convey the same to the owner of the adjoining lands.

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention of The Corporation of the City of North Bay to close same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the local newspaper.

AND WHEREAS the said Council has undertaken to hear in person or by their counsel, solicitor or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-law and who applies to be heard.


NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing and being composed of that part of the lane which lies between lots facing on King Street and Victoria Street as shown on said registered Plan 57, being the full width of the said lane running from the northerly limit of Ferguson Street to a straight line joining the northerly limits of lots 85 and 128 shown on the said plan, be and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. THAT the said part of the said lane be properly described for purposes of registration and be made the subject of a conveyance from the City of North Bay to the owner of the lands adjoining same.
