THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 2335

Being a By-law authorizing the installation of sanitary conveniences and connections in the premises known as Municipal Number 1604 Harriett Street, North Bay, Ontario, and being Lot 7 as shown on Plan 53 for the City of North Bay registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing at the expense of the owners of such property.

WHEREAS the North Bay Area Health Unit, by reason of the unsanitary condition of the existing septic tank of the above-described lands and premises, has recommended that the necessary sanitary sewer conveniences and connections be installed in the above-described lands and premises in order that the same may be connected with the common sanitary sewer of the City and that the cost thereof be paid by the owners in accordance with The Public Health Act R.S.O. 1960 Chapter 321 Section 24(2), (2a) and (3) by reason of the fact that the owners of the said lands and premises are unable to pay the expense of the aforesaid installation at once;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

nections be installed in the above-described lands and premises at a cost not exceeding the sum of Three Hundred and Sicty-six dollars (\$366.00) and that the cost thereof, including interest at the rate of *5 on the deferred payments, be paid by the owners of the said property in equal, successive, annual payments extending over a period of five (5) years and that such annual payments be added by the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay to the Collector's Roll and collected in like manner as Municipal Taxes.
