THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 14-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 72-70, A BY-LAW TO REVISE THE SALARIES AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES OF THE ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend Section 1 of By-law No. 72-70.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Section 1 of By-law No. 72-70 be amended by substituting the word "five (5)" for the word "twelve (12)" wherever the last mentioned word and number appear in such Section 1 so that the said Section shall now read:

SECTION 1

"That in the event that an Alderman is absent in any year from more than five (5) regularly called meetings of Council or of Council in Committee, the sum of \$30.00 shall be deducted from the salary of such Alderman for each such meeting in excess of five (5); provided that such sum shall not be deducted in the case of an Alderman being absent from a meeting by reason of being required to attend elsewhere in the business of the City if such absence is authorized by a resolution of Council."

2. THAT this by-law shall be retroactive to and come into force as of the 1st day of January, 1972.
