The Corporation of the City of North Bay is currently seeking applications for the position of Engineer in Training (EIT).

Reporting to the Senior Capital Program Engineer, this position is responsible for assisting with the design, design management, procurement, and construction management of various Capital projects within the City and for gathering, documenting, and analysing various data regarding City assets. The EIT will also assist with the review and approval of the Engineering aspects of private developments within the City as well as undertaking studies, analysis and preparing recommendations for traffic, capital planning, and asset management. The Intern provides engineering expertise, including interpretation, adaptation and implementation of established guidelines, regulations and best management practices as related to provincial legislation, infrastructure maintenance, and replacement/rehabilitation of City assets.

The position is an entry level position with progressive responsibility and will provide the required experience to acquire a Professional Engineering License and progress towards a Project Engineer position.
