BY-LAW NO. 68-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF \$1,565,400 UPON DEBENTURES TOWARDS THE COST OF WATERMAINS, STREET LIGHTING AND HYDRO EXTENSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay has passed the following by-laws authorizing the following works for which it is now desirable to issue debentures in the following amounts:-

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purposes aforesaid, there shall be borrowed upon the credit of the Corporation at large the sum of \$1,565,400 in lawful money of Canada, and the Corporation shall issue debentures therefor in denominations of not less than \$50 each.

2. The debentures shall be dated the 14th day of July, 1972, shall be issued at one time and shall be payable in twenty annual instalments of principal on the 14th day of July in each of the years 1973 to 1992, both inclusive, and shall bear interest payable semiannually on the 14th days of January and July in each year. The debentures shall have coupons attached for the payment of such interest. The debentures maturing in the years 1973 to 1977, both inclusive, shall bear interest at the rate of seven and one-half percent per annum, the debentures maturing in the years 1978 to 1982, both inclusive, shall bear interest at the rate of eight percent per annum and the debentures maturing in the years 1983 to 1992, both inclusive, shall bear interest at the rate of eight and one-quarter percent per annum. The respective amounts of principal and interest payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "A" hereto annexed and forming part of this by-law.

3. The debentures shall be payable as to both principal and interest in lawful money of Canada at the principal office of The Royal Bank of Canada in any of the cities of North Bay, Toronto or Montreal, at the holder's optior.

4. The debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation and signed by the Mayor of the Corporation or by some other person authorized by by-law to sign them and by the Treasurer, and the interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer. The **Sig**nature of the Mayor to the debentures, the signature of the Treasurer on the interest coupons and, if such debentures are countersigned in writing by the Deputy Treasurer, the signature of the Treasurer to the debentures may be written or engrave, lithographed, printed or otherwise mechanically reproduced. 5. Commencing in the year 1973, and thereafter in each year during the currency of the said debentures, there shall be raised by a special rate sufficient therefor, over and above all other rates, on all the rateable property in the City of North Bay, the amount of the instalment of principal and interest payable in that year as set forth in Schedule "A" hereunto annexed, but no greater amount shall be raised than is required after taking into account receipts from any other sources with respect to such works, including any water rates imposed under section 362 of The Municipal Act with respect to such works.

6. The debentures may contain any provision for their registration authorized by law.

7. This by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64(1) of The Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1970, Ch. 323.
