BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1298

WHEREAS BY-Law No. 1298 is a By-Law regulating the traffic on the Public Highways of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend the said By-Law .

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Paragraph 16 of the said By-Law No. 1298 be amended by adding Subsection C, which subsection shall read as follows:

C. "No Vehicle shall be driven over any bridge in the City of North Bay as hereinafter listed with over a maximum weight including both vehicle and load as follows:

	BRIDGE	MAXIMUM WEIGHT including both truck and load.
Cassells Street near Chippewa Street	Concrete	15 Tons
Fisher Street near Princess Street	Concrete	15 Tons
Hammond Street near Third Avenue	Concrete	15 Tons
John Street near Second Avenue	Concrete	15 Tons
Chippewa St. West near Rose Ave.	Wooden	3½ Tons
Chippewa St. East between Wyld and Fisher Street	Wooden	3½ Tons
Duke St. East between Wyld and Fisher Street	Wooden	3½ Tons
Second Avenue, East of Regina St.	Wooden	2 Tons
Worthington St. East between John and Metcalfe Street	Wooden	3½ Tons
McIntyre St. East between John and Metcalfe Street	Steel Beams	15 Tons
Homer Avenue between Monck and Memorial Drive	Wooden	3½ Tons

PROVIDED, however, that the provisions of this section shall not come into effect until signs have been erected on the approaches to both ends of said bridges setting forth the maximum weight allowed.
