THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 32-93

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 20-72 TO PERMIT MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLES ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to permit the operation of motorized snow vehicles on parts of certain high-ways in the City of North Bay where it is necessary to allow for a route from Lake Nipissing to Trout Lake;

AND WHEREAS such operation shall be in strict compliance with the conditions set out in this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 5 of By-law 20-72 is hereby amended by designating the existing section 5 as "(1)" and by inserting the following after paragraph "5 (1) (d)":
 - '5. (2) (a) No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle on any highway in the City of North Bay except those highways or parts thereof listed and for the limited time referred to on Schedule "C".
 - (b) Any person operating a motorized snow vehicle on a highway listed on Schedule "C"
 - (i) shall not exceed 20 kilometres per hour,
 - (ii) shall travel in single file,
 - (iii) shall travel as close to the right
 hand shoulder of the road as
 conditions permit."
