## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 34-77

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2100 WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN POLICY MATTERS, AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 55-74.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay considers it advisable to amend By-law No. 2100 to establish a policy for payment of salaries to members of the North Bay Planning Board.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That a new paragraph be added to By-law No. 2100 to establish a policy for payment of salaries to members of the North Bay Planning Board as follows:
  - "19. (b) (i) That members of the Planning Board of the City of North Bay be paid a salary of \$1,000.00 per annum.
    - (ii) That in the event a member of the Planning Board is absent in any year from more than three meetings of the Planning Board, the sum of \$25.00 shall be deducted from the salary of such member for each such meeting in excess of three."
- 2. That By-law No. 55-74 be and is hereby repealed.
- That this By-law shall take effect as of the first day of January 1977.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 7TH DAY OF MARCH, 1977. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 21ST DAY OF MARCH, 1977. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 21ST DAY OF MARCH, 1977.
