BY-LAW NO. 1376

 $$\tt BEING\ A\ BY-LAW\ covering\ the\ formation\ of\ a\ Civilian\ Defence\ Committee\ for\ the\ City\ of\ North\ Bay.$

WHEREAS for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of North Bay, it is deemed advisable to set up a Civilian Defence Committee.

AND WHEREAS a special Committee has reported on the personel of such Civilian Defence Committee.

THEREFORE the MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That a Civilian Defence Committee be set up for the Municipality of the City of North Bay.
- 2. That the personel of the said Civilian Defence Committee be as follows:
- (a) Mr. D. G. Stevens be appointed as Chairman of said Committee
- (b) Mr. Sid Cohen be appointed as Secretary of said Committee.
- (c) Mr. C. O. Colbert, be appointed as Vice-Chairman of said Committee.
- (d) Fire Chief G. R. Thomas be appointed Chairman of Fire Service in connection with said Civilian Defence Committee.
- (e) Chief of Police E.A. Forsyth be appointed Chairman of Police Service in connection with said Civilian Defence Committee.
- (f) Dr. A. E. Ranney be appointed Chairman of Medical and First Aid Service of said Committee.
- (g) Mr. E. J. Roche be appointed Chairman of Transportation and Communication Service of said Committee.
- (h) Mr. G. E. Elnor be appointed Chairman of Public Utilities Service of said Committee.
- (i) Mr. J. J. Dennis be appointed Chief Warden and Organizer at a salary of \$100.00 per month.
- 3. That the Treasurer be instructed to set apart a Contingency Fund in the sum of \$1000.00 to cover cost of Office Switchboard, advertising etc.
- 4. That the Central Control Room of the said Civilian Defence Committee be located in the City Hall Board Room in the City Hall, North Bay.
- 5. That the Chief Organizer be and is hereby authorized to immediately seek necessary zone wardens etc. and the proper authorities be at once advised.

READ a Second Time in Open Council this 8th. day of December, 1942.

RULES OF ORDER were suspended and By-Law read a third time short and passed this 8th. day of December 1942.
