

BY-LAW NO. 1485

BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 1421, a By-Law revising the salaries of the Aldermen of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said By-Law No. 1421.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Paragraph No. 1 of By-Law No. 1421 be repealed and the following substituted therefore;

(1) That each duly elected Alderman of the City of North Bay be paid the annual remuneration of \$150.00, payable quarterly, with an additional allowance of \$150.00 for expenses over and above any expenses incurred by him when attending meetings or conventions on behalf of the Municipality when held outside the City of North Bay.

PROVIDED, however, that there shall be a deduction, of SEVEN DOLLARS (\$7.00) from each Alderman for each meeting of Council not attended by him and a further deduction of THREE DOLLARS (\$3.00) for each of his Committee Meetings not attended.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 16th DAY OF JUNE, 1947.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 16th DAY OF JUNE, 1947.

RULES OF ORDER WERE SUSPENDED AND BY-LAW READ A THIRD TIME SHORT AND PASSED THIS 16th DAY OF JUNE, 1947.
